Meeting Minutes

Present: Kevin O'Bryan, Bill Dunne, Lou Anthony, Hon. Dean Bodnar, Paul Carroll, Tina Urzan, Lisa Kyer and Steve Bouchey

Also in attendance: Justin Miller, Monica Kurzejeski, Ken Crowe, Bob Boucher, Jeff Gordon, Selena Skiba and Denee Zeigler

The Chairman called the CRC portion of the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

I. Additional security camera funding

Bill Dunne advised that the City has come to us for additional \$50,000 of funding to purchase security cameras in areas that are in need. Lisa Kyer asked about the kinds of cameras they are looking at purchasing and where they were to be installed. Mr. Dunne advised they will be installed by Intervid, the same company they used for cameras downtown. He explained that he is not able to say exactly where they will be installed. They will not be adding additional cameras downtown, rather they will be installed in other areas of the City. Tina Urzan spoke about wanting to have cameras installed in North Central at one time, but the technology wasn't available to get clear enough images. Mr. Dunne advised that additional towers have been installed that allow the camera images to become clearer. Mr. Urzan asked if funds from the recent batch of

Hon. Dean Bodnar made a motion to approve \$50,000 of additional funding for additional security cameras to be installed in the City of Troy.

Lou Anthony seconded the motion, motion carried.

II. Downtown wireless

Monica Kurzejeski spoke the board about the Massive Mesh project to provide free internet access throughout downtown Troy. A CFA grant application was submitted by the creators and has scored really well. The project will be truly wireless and is growing quickly. The next step of their project is to apply for grants and hire management. They are asking for grants through the County and assistance from the CRC. The chairman asked to have a resolution prepared for the next meeting in order to discuss. Mr. Bouchey noted it puts us on the road with other cities. Mr. Miller asked where they mount the equipment needed. Mrs. Kurzejeski advised they have entered into private agreements with people.

III. Financials

Selena Skiba handed out a copy of the financials to the board members. She advised not much activity but did note the profit/loss section that shows the fees for conducting the audit.

IV. Kevin O'Bryan thanked the board.

(City Security Camera Funding Agreement)

A regular meeting of the City of Troy Capital Resource Corporation was convened on September 12, 2014, at 10:30 a.m.

The following resolution was duly offered and seconded, to wit:

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY CAPITAL RESOURCE CORPORATION AUTHORIZING (i) THE ISSUANCE OF A \$50,000 GRANT TO THE CITY OF TROY FOR A SECURITY CAMERA PROJECT (AS DEFINED HEREIN) AND (ii) THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A GRANT AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 402 and 1411 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law (“N-PCL”) of the State of New York, the City of Troy Capital Resource Corporation (“CRC”) was established as a domestic, not-for-profit local development corporation pursuant to a Certificate of Incorporation filed on November 20, 2009 (the “Certificate”) to undertake certain charitable and public purposes, among other things, including relieving and reducing unemployment, promoting and providing for additional and maximum employment, bettering and maintaining job opportunities, instructing or training individuals to improve or develop their capabilities for such jobs, carrying on scientific research for the purpose of aiding the City of Troy, New York (the “City”) by attracting new industry to the City or by encouraging the development of, or retention of, an industry in the City, and lessening the burdens of government and acting in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the N-PCL and the Certificate, the CRC has established a Community and Economic Development funding program (the “CRC Program”) whereby the CRC provides funding to certain projects, programs and organizations to undertake community and economic development programs within the City; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents, the City proposes to undertake the installation of security cameras and related electronic surveillance equipment within defined areas of the City (collectively, the “Project”), such Project being more particularly described within the proposal attached hereto as **Exhibit A**; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the City’s desire to undertake the Project, which will enhance public safety and economic development within the City, the City has requested funding assistance from CRC in the amount of \$50,000.00 (the “Grant”), the provision of such Grant being consistent with the N-PCL and the Certificate; and

WHEREAS, the CRC desires to authorize the Grant and execution of related Grant Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF TROY CAPITAL RESOURCE CORPORATION AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Corporation hereby authorizes the provision of the Grant to the City in furtherance of the Project. The Chairman, Vice Chairman and/or the Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation are hereby authorized, on behalf of the Corporation, to execute and deliver a Grant Agreement, along with related documents (collectively, the "Documents"), in such form as prepared and approved by counsel to the Corporation and as approved by the Chairman, Vice Chairman and/or the Chief Executive Officer.

Section 2. The Secretary or Assistant Secretary of the Corporation are hereby authorized, where appropriate, to affix the seal of the Corporation to the Documents and to attest the same, all with such changes, variations, omissions and insertions as the Chairman, Vice Chairman and/or Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation shall approve, and the execution thereof by the Chairman, Vice Chairman and/or Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation to constitute conclusive evidence of such approval.

Section 3. The officers, employees and agents of the Corporation are hereby authorized and directed for and in the name and on behalf of the Corporation to do all acts and things required and to execute and deliver all such checks, certificates, instruments and documents, to pay all such fees, charges and expenses and to do all such further acts and things as may be necessary or, in the opinion of the officer, employee or agent acting, desirable and proper to effect the purposes of the foregoing resolutions and to cause compliance by the Corporation with all of the terms, covenants and provisions of the documents executed for and on behalf of the Corporation.

Section 4. These Resolutions shall take effect immediately.

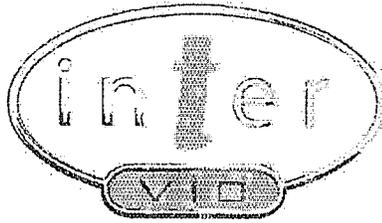
