## Minutes of Meeting March 18, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M.


- 1) **Consider the minutes of the March 18, 2014 meeting.** Following review, a motion was made by Commissioner LaPosta, seconded by Chairperson Rauh to accept the minutes. All voted in favor, 2-0.
- 2) **Consider an MSD-222A to create three (3) additional Police Officer positions (COT).** The City of Troy was able to hire additional Officers as a result of a grant, and the MSD-222A will increase the number of positions in the Civil Service roster. On a motion by Commissioner LaPosta, seconded by Chairperson Rauh, all voted in favor, 2- 0.
- 3) **Review Certification of Troy Public Library Payroll for 2014.** The Commission commends the Library for its cooperation and swift action to enable 2014 certification. On a motion by Commissioner LaPosta, seconded by Chairperson Rauh, all voted to accept the Troy Public Library payroll certification, 2-0.
- 4) **Establish an eligible list for four (4) years for Library Assistant (TPL).** On a motion by Commissioner LaPosta, seconded by Chairperson Rauh, all voted in favor, 2-0.
- 5) **Establish an eligible list for four (4) years for Accountant (COT).** On a motion by Commissioner LaPosta, seconded by Chairperson Rauh, all voted in favor, 2-0.
- 6) **Review Troy Civil Service Commission Annual Report for 2013.** Following review, on a motion by Commissioner LaPosta, seconded by Chairperson Rauh, all voted to accept the 2013 Annual Report as submitted to the New York State Department of Civil Service, 2-0.


The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 15, 2014, 9:00 A.M., Troy City Hall main conference room.
