Notice is hereby given that the Planning Board of the City of Troy, New York will conduct a public hearing on **Tuesday, August 31st, 2004 at 7:00 P.M.** in the Second Floor Council Chambers of City Hall in order to hear and decide on proposals for development as follows:

PB2004-0054s SEQRA and Site Plan Review of a proposal to construct an athletic support building and improve the Lower Renwyck field on the RPI Campus by replacing the grass with a turf field and adding bleachers. Project location is Georgian Court, South of Michigan Ave. Applicant is RPI 110 8th St, Troy, NY 12180.

PB2004-0060s Conceptual Site Plan Review of a proposal to utilize a vacant site for aggregate loading and shipping for one year. Project location is East Industrial Parkway, north of the Rensselaer County Jail. Applicant is ACC-RJV, LLC, 315 Partition St. Rensselaer, NY 12144.

PB2004-0064h Historic District Landmark Advisory Review of a proposal to demolish the rear half of a building in the 3rd Street Local Historic District for expansion of a parking lot. Project location is 45 Third Street, between Broadway and State. Applicant is E. Stewart Jones, 28 2nd St., Troy, NY 12180.

PB2004-0068s Preliminary Site Plan Review of a proposal to convert a former 1-story retail business into a café. Project location is 1527 College Avenue, at 15th. Applicant is RPI, 110 Eighth St. Troy, NY 12180.

PB2004-0071h Historic District & Landmark Advisory Review of a proposal to install 3 permanent banner signs on light poles around the Troy Savings Bank Music hall. Project location is 32 Second Street, at State. Applicant is Troy Savings Bank Music Hall, 32 Second St. Troy, NY 12180.

SEQRA determination for the Upper Congress Street Reconstruction Project. Project location is Congress Street from 11th Street to Brunswick Road. Applicant is City of Troy, 1 Monument Square, Troy, NY 12180.
