Sometimes we are asked . . .

Q: Where can I get my divorce documents?

A: Matters of divorce are handled by the County Clerk's Office.

Q: Where can I pay my traffic ticket?

A: These matters are handled by Troy City Court. (518) 453-5900

Q: When is my next court date?

A: These matters are handled by the Troy City Court. (518) 453-5900

Q: What is the eviction process?

A: Evictions start with Troy City Court. (518) 453-5900.

Q: My child was born in Troy, NY, where can I obtain a birth certificate?

A: The Vital Statistics Department at the City of Troy.

Q: My parents/grandparents were married in Troy, NY, how can I get a copy of their marriage license?

A: They would have to have obtained their Marriage License at this office in order for a copy to be here – otherwise check the Town Clerks or City Hall offices in the area. Then submit the application and \$22.00 for the search fee.

Q: Where do I go to apply for a handgun permit?

A: Gun permits are handled by the County Clerk's office – (518) 270-4080

Q: Where can I get a Certificate of Residency?

A: Certificates of Residence are issued by the County CFO for Rensselaer County residents attending community colleges outside Rensselaer County.

Q: My dog is missing, where can I find him or her?

A: Your dog was probably outside walking around without tags or a license and was picked up by our Animal Control Officer. If your dog is licensed and was picked up, it may be at the Menands Shelter – (518) 434-8128.
