Length of time allotted for citizen comment shall be no longer than ten (10) minutes per speaker. A verbal attack on any individual is unacceptable and will neither be tolerated nor allowed.

ORDINANCES

1. Ordinance amending the 2008 City Budget to transfer funds within the General, Water & Sewer Fund budget lines. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
2. Ordinance amending the 2008 City Budget to accept funds from the New York State Department of Criminal Justice Services for the purpose of appropriating expenditures as defined in the IMPACT V grant agreement and budget. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
3. Ordinance amending the 2008 City Budget to accept donated funds in the amount of \$10,780.00 for the purpose of purchases relating to the Powers Park Concert Series and other City civic events. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
4. Ordinance amending the 2008 Community Development Budget and Troy Homes Project # 2072-5176. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
5. Ordinance authorizing the appropriation from the City of Troy 2008 Reserved Worker's Compensation Fund balance and amending the 2008 General Fund for the purpose of settling a worker's compensation case potentially saving the City of Troy approximately \$530,000 over the life of the case. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).

6. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute a full release and satisfaction of all liens, encumbrances, guarantees and attachments the City of Troy has—including the UDAG and Section 108 Loan—as against the River Triangle (246-276 River Street) and Dauchy (275-283 River Street) Buildings and River Triangle Company (The “Owner”) and its Partners. (Council President Campana).
7. Ordinance amending the City’s Non-Represented Employees’ Policy. (Council President Campana).

Resolutions

1. Resolution authorizing the implementation, and funding in the first instance 100% of the Federal—Aid and State “Marchiselli” Program—aid eligible costs of a transportation Federal-Aid-Project and appropriating funds therefore. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
2. Resolution appointing Commissioners of Deeds. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
3. Resolution authorizing issuance of a commercial lessor’s Bingo License to Bingo Green, Inc., D/B/A “Troy Atrium Bingo”. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration) .
