**Ordinance Amending the City's Non-Represented Employees' Policy – Previously Adopted by the City Council at a Special Meeting on 1-08-08 and vetoed by the Mayor on 1-23-08**

The City of Troy, in City Council, ordained as follows:

Section 1. The City of Troy has previous legislation to enact a policy setting forth the wages, benefits, working conditions and other terms of employment for all City employees who are not represented by a bargaining unit.

Section 2. Said policy calls for periodic review and update.

Section 3. The City of Troy hereby amends the City's Non-Represented Employees' Policy as set forth in Section 1, Salaries, to read as follows:

Section 1 Salaries

Group B – Shall receive the same annual increase as those determined by the current CSEA contract (i.e. 2007 – 3.5% & 2008 – 3.5%), subject to the approval of the City Council.

Section 4. This law shall take effect immediately.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING § 2-11 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF TROY  
ACCESS TO CITY RECORDS – Previously adopted by the City Council  
at a Special Meeting on 1-08-08 and vetoed by the Mayor on 1-23-08**

---

The City of Troy, in City Council, ordained as follows:

Section 1. The City of Troy has previous legislation to enact a policy setting forth access to public records, including the denial of access to said records.

Section 2. The City of Troy hereby amends § 2-11 (H) of the Troy City Code as follows:

H. Denial of access to records:

- (1) Denial of access to records shall be in writing stating the reason therefor and advising the requester of the right to appeal to the individual or body established to hear appeals within 30 days of a denial.
- (2) The City Council Standing Committee on Law, shall hear appeals for denial of access to records under the Freedom of Information Law.
- (3) The time for deciding an appeal by the City Council Standing Committee on Law shall commence upon receipt of a written appeal identifying:
  - (a) The date of the appeal.
  - (b) The date and location of the requests for records.
  - (c) The records to which the requester was denied access.
  - (d) Whether the denial was in writing or due to failure to provide records in a timely manner as required by this section and,
  - (e) The name and address of the requester.
- (4) The City Council Standing Committee on Law shall inform the requester of ~~his or her~~ **its** decision in writing within 10 business days of receipt of an appeal.
- (5) The City Council Standing Committee on Law shall transmit a copy of all appeals upon their receipt to the Committee on Open Government at its office in Albany.
- (6) The City Council Standing Committee on Law shall inform the appellant and the Committee on Open Government of its determination in writing within 10 business days of receipt of an appeal.

Section 3. This law shall take effect immediately.
