1. Local Law No. 1 (Intro #1) for the year 2009 amending the Troy City Charter. (Council President Campana).
2. Local Law No. 2 (Intro #2) for the year 2009 amending C-76 (C) of the Troy City Charter. (Council President Campana).

ORDINANCES

1. Ordinance authorizing the appropriation from the City of Troy 2008 reserved fund balance (capital reserve) and amending the 2009 capital fund for the purpose of authorizing and appropriating funds necessary for the retro fit and move of City Hall to the former Verizon Building. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
2. Ordinance amending the 2009 General Fund City Service-Administration budget to Transfer funds from permanent salaries to part-time salaries. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
3. Ordinance amending the 2009 City budget to amend Weed and Seed appropriations per revisions to the "2008-2009 Weed and Seed Grant Award". (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).

4. Ordinance amending the 2009 General Fund City budget to accept a “State Urban Area Supplemental Program Grant” on behalf of the NYS Office of Homeland Security for the development and purchase of upgraded and enhanced security, communications, and computer system equipment and training. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
5. Ordinance amending the 2009 General Fund City budget to accept a “Guns off the Street” grant from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
6. Ordinance amending the 2009 special revenue fund to establish a project for the remediation of the waterfront park site off of Ingall’s Avenue (formerly Jack’s Junkyard). (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
7. Ordinance amending the 2008-2009 CDBG One-Year Action Plan budget to create a new public facilities project with existing CDBG funds for the North Street Firehouse Neighborhood Rehabilitation project. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
8. Ordinance enacting a moratorium on certain sections within Chapter 285 “zoning” of the Troy Code of Ordinances by prohibiting: the subdivision of residential structures; the conversion of garages, carriage houses or secondary structures to residential units; the increase in the number of bedrooms in an existing residential unit. (Council Member Brown) (At the Request of the Administration).
9. Ordinance authorizing the reconveyance of real property taken by the City of Troy through the In-Rem foreclosure process. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
10. Ordinance authorizing the City to accept ownership of certain lands presently owned by the Troy Housing Authority, a municipal corporation , and located within the Congress Street/ Ferry Street Corridor. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration)
11. Ordinance amending the 2009 general fund City budget to authorize a change to the Troy Public Library contract with the City of Troy and appropriate all (\$450,000) funds to the main branch of the Troy Public Library. (Council President Campana) (At the Request of the Administration).
