TUTUNJIAN ANNOUNCES SIDEWALK PROGRAM

(Troy – August 5, 2010) Mayor Harry Tutunjian announced today that the 2009-2010 Neighborhood Sidewalk Improvement Contract has been finalized.

"Working with the City Council, we were able to target several areas for these infrastructure improvements that will improve pedestrian safety and provide greater accessibility for disabled people," said Mayor Tutunjian. "The neighborhood groups proposed much larger scale projects; we are doing the most we can with the limited funding approved by the City Council."

Tutunjian noted that sidewalk replacement is the responsibility of the property owner. In these locations however, the City Council approved using these funds to make the repairs for the property owners

This project includes sidewalk and curb replacement demonstration projects at the following locations:

1. Southwest corner of 1st St. and Van Buren St. sidewalk replacement 2. Northeast corner of 2nd St. and Harrison St. sidewalk and curb replacement 3. Southwest corner of 4th St. and Van Buren St. sidewalk and curb replacement 4. Northeast corner of Mill St. and Erie St. sidewalk and curb at bus stop 5. Southeast corner of 1st St. and Liberty St. catch basin and curb ramp 6. Southeast corner of Washington St. and Frear alley catch basin and curb ramp 7. Northwest corner of Washington St. and Frear alley catch basin and curb ramp 8. Northwest corner of 1st Ave. and 112th St. sidewalk along the new 112th St. Bridge Park.

The work will be performed by Bob Talham, Inc. and the total contract amount is \$78,699.81 paid for using federal CDBG funding, through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
