Thank you for continuing to consult with the New York State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). We have reviewed the submitted materials in accordance with the New York State Historic Preservation Act of 1980 (section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law). These comments are those of the Division for Historic Preservation and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources.

We have reviewed your recent submission for the Ida Dam project. This submission includes additional information regarding the proposed emergency dam breach at the Upper Mill Dam.

Based on this review, it is the opinion of the SHPO that the proposed project will have No Adverse Impact to historic and cultural resources provided the following conditions are incorporated into the project:

1. Continued consultation with our office as the projected long term treatment plans for the dam become available. As previously noted, a dam at this location is significant to the historic district and we recommend that plans be developed to retain a dam at this location.
