Patrick T. Morphy, Chairman. Mr. Morphy is a retired attorney, having participated in a mixture of private practice and public service. He obtained his law degree from Albany Law School in 1977. Most related, Mr. Morphy served as Corporation Counsel for the City of Troy from 1995 to 2003. He later retired from his position as Assistant Attorney General in the New York State Attorney General's Office. Mr. Morphy resides in Troy, New York.

Kenneth J. Baer. Mr. Baer is founder of Baer Real Estate, established in 1973 in the City of Troy, which manages, develops, and brokers commercial and residential buildings in Troy and the surrounding area. Mr. Baer was educated at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York, where he earned a B.S. degree in Management Science.

Michelle (Chelly) Hegan. Ms. Hegan has served as President/CEO of Upper Hudson Planned Parenthood since 2012 and began her tenure at Planned Parenthood in 2006 when she served as Vice President for Human Resources and then as Senior Vice President for Operations. Her educational background combines studies in sociology and Fine Arts and includes a B.A. from Hartwick College, and a M.A. and M.F.A. from the University at Albany. Prior to joining the team at UHPP, Ms. Hegan worked at the Albany/Schenectady League of Arts, and for The Kaleel Jamison Consulting Group, Inc. She has served as a Board member for many community agencies including Troy Public Library, Sponsor a Scholar, Columbia County Health Care Consortium, the Pride Center of the Capital Region and the Center for Women in Government and Civil Society.

Lynn M. Kopka. Ms. Kopka is a long-time homeowner and resident of Troy, NY. She previously held the positions of Assistant Secretary to the NYS Senate Finance Committee for the Democratic Minority; Director of Planning for the City of Troy; Director of Housing Policy and Management for the NYS Office of the Director of Housing; and Assistant Commissioner for the NYS Division of Homes and Community Renewal. Ms. Kopka also serviced three terms on the Troy City Council, including one term as president. She is also the owner and operator of Kopka Clothes, a custom clothier. She has served as a board member on the Washington Park Association, Spaying Capital Region Unowned Feral Felines, Commission on Economic Opportunity and Friends of Washington Park.
