101. Resolution Acknowledging Receipt Of The Mayor's 2021 Recommended City Budget And Setting The Dates For The Public Hearings On The Proposed Budget's Estimates For 2021 (Council President Mantello) **To Be Added Via Unanimous Consent

***PUBLIC FORUM**

Troy residents who wish to comment during the public forum at the beginning of the meeting must have the ability to join the Zoom meeting via computer or phone and will be required to pre-register for the meeting. The link to register for the meeting will be posted at least 24 hours before the meeting on the Council [Agenda and Minutes](#) page. You must register for the meeting by 3 pm on the day of the meeting.

Per the City Council, written comments will not be read aloud at this meeting but will be added to the meeting minutes. Written comments to be added to the meeting minutes should be sent to mara.drogan@troyny.gov and must be received by 3 pm on the day of the meeting. You must include your full name and residential address, as required by Council rules. Written comments received after 3 pm shall be treated as correspondence and forwarded to the Council for their review.

RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE MAYOR'S 2021 RECOMMENDED CITY BUDGET AND SETTING THE DATES FOR THE PUBLIC HEARINGS ON THE PROPOSED BUDGET'S ESTIMATES FOR 2021

WHEREAS, pursuant to §C-47 (E)(1) of the Troy City Charter, the Mayor shall file the Mayor's 2021 Budget Message and Recommended 2021 Budget for the City of Troy with the Troy City Clerk no later than October 10, 2020; and

WHEREAS, pursuant §C-47 (F) of the Charter, the City Council shall meet in special session no later than October 15, 2020, to refer the recommended budget to the City Council's Finance Committee, which shall in turn refer the budget recommendations for City Departments to the appropriate standing committees of the City Council to hold preliminary public hearings regarding the portion of the recommended 2021 City Budget applicable to the respective standing committees; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §C-47 (H) (1) of the Charter, following the preliminary public hearings held by the Finance Committee and the other standing committees, the various committees shall issue reports of their respective hearings to the City Clerk no later than November 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, pursuant §C-47 (I) of the Charter, after the Council committees file their reports with the Clerk, the Mayor, the Budget Officer, and the City Council shall convene to review suggested changes to the recommended 2021 City Budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §C-47 (J) of the Charter, subsequent to the above meeting, the City Council or the standing Finance Committee shall meet and hold a final public hearing on the budget estimates contained in the proposed 2021 City Budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §C-47 (K) of the Charter, after the final public hearing, the City Council shall hold a special meeting on or before December 1, 2020, or December 2, 2020, if December 1 falls on a Sunday, for the purpose of a passing a resolution to adopt the recommended 2021 City Budget, or to amend and adopt the 2021 recommended City Budget as amended, and to submit the same to the Mayor for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council acknowledges the filing and receipt of the Mayor's 2021 Budget Message and recommended 2021 City Budget; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council shall hold a special meeting on Tuesday, October 13, 2020, at 5:30 p.m., to consider the recommended 2021 City Budget and to refer the recommended budget to the Finance Committee, which shall in turn refer the budget recommendations for the City Departments to the appropriate standing committees of the City Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the standing committees of the City Council shall meet to conduct preliminary public hearings regarding those parts of the recommended 2021 City Budget applicable to the respective committees in accordance with the following schedule:

- Finance – Thursday, October 15, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.
- Public Utilities – Tuesday, October 20, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.
- Science and Technology – Tuesday, October 20, 2020, at 6:30 p.m.

- Planning – Tuesday, October 20, 2020, at 7:00 p.m.
- Law Committee – Thursday, October 22, 2020, at 5:30 p.m.
- 2021 Capital Plan - Thursday, October 22, 2020, at 5:45 p.m.
- Public Safety – Tuesday, October 27, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.
- General Services – Thursday, October 29, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.
- General Services (Sanitation) – Thursday, November 5, 2020, at 5:30 p.m.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above standing committees will issue and file their reports on the preliminary public hearings with the City Clerk on or before Sunday, November 15, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, the Budget Officer and the City Council will meet on Tuesday, November 17, 2020, at 6:00 p.m., for a public budget meeting to review suggested changes to the recommended 2021 City Budget; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council shall hold a final public hearing on the 2021 City Budget, including the Capital Budget, on Thursday, November 19, 2020, at 7:00 p.m.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council shall hold a special meeting to adopt the recommended 2021 City Budget or the recommended 2021 City Budget as amended on Tuesday, November 24, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.
