


What is Mobility Hub?

- Connections to transit and shared-use services
- CDTA investing in built environment near bus stops
 - Enhance waiting areas for transit users
 - Improve pedestrian infrastructure/access
 - Co-location of mobility services (CYCLE bike-share, DRIVE car-share, etc.)
- In partnership with municipalities




Existing Conditions




Troy Mobility Hub location

- Identified by CDTA and City of Troy
- Safety improvements via closing of “slip lane”
- Complements 4th Street upgrades + future Little Italy Marketplace project



Project Components

- Transportation amenities
- Enhanced public space
- Intersection improvements
- Parking spaces relocated

Next Steps

- CDTA will bid out mobility hub project late 2023
 - Construction anticipated to start spring 2024 (complete by summer)
 - Hill Street slip lane will be permanently closed (~April)
- Confirm name: “Hill Street” or “Liberty Square” mobility hub
