










Priority Projects

1. Shared-use path on Congress Street Bridge (shared Troy/Watervliet)
2. Connect River Street and remove ramps (Troy)
3. Convert Front Street to a trail (Troy)
4. Ferry Street Corridor (Troy)
5. Downsize 19th Street and 2nd Street intersection (Watervliet)
6. Southern connection to Hudson Shores Park (Watervliet)
7. Traffic calming on 23rd Street (2nd Avenue to Hudson Shores Park) (Watervliet)
