Troy Officials: City Hall Closed in Observation of Independence Day

Garbage and recycling collection suspended for holiday on Tuesday, July 4

TROY, NY – City officials have announced that Troy City Hall will be closed on Tuesday, July 4, in observation of Independence Day and will reopen on Wednesday, July 5, at 8:30 a.m.

In addition, city officials have announced that there will be no garbage or recycling pickup on Tuesday, July 4. Residents who normally receive Tuesday garbage and recycling pickup should bring their garbage and recycling to the curb on Tuesday evening for collection on Wednesday, July 5. The normal garbage collection schedule will resume on Wednesday, July 5. City bulk trash pickup will **not** be available for Tuesday, July 4.

To assist those with mobility issues, including the disabled and elderly, Troy residents are asked to keep sidewalks adjacent to their property free of obstacles when placing garbage and recycling bins out for collection.

Residents are also reminded to observe all posted parking restrictions for regularly-scheduled street sweeping operations in their neighborhood. Improperly parked vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.
