South Troy
Canal Street Park
(3rd Street and Canal Ave.)

Splash pads are open to the public at various city parks, including: Frear Park, Prospect Park, Knickerbacker Park and Riverfront Park. The Troy Housing Authority will allow residents to access to their six Splash Pad Play Areas located at Phelan Court, Fallon

Apartments, Griswold Heights, Martin Luther King Apartments, the Taylor Apartments and Corliss Park.
