City Officials Issue Traffic Advisory for Congress Street

TROY, NY – City officials have issued a traffic advisory for Congress Street for scheduled sewer maintenance operations.

Congress Street will be closed between 15th Street and Brunswick Avenue from 6:00 a.m., to 4:00 p.m., Sunday, September 16. During the closure, eastbound traffic will be detoured using 15th Street to Tibbets Avenue to Orchard Avenue. Westbound traffic will be detoured using Pawling Avenue to Linden Avenue to Spring Avenue.

Motorists should watch for signs, follow the posted detours, and seek alternate routes where possible. Motorists are reminded to watch for flaggers and use caution near work zones to ensure the safety of workers. Local emergency services have been notified of the traffic restrictions and lane closures. Additionally, all homes and businesses in the area will continue to be accessible during the road closure.
