(120th Street and 1st Ave.)

**Little Italy**  
Little Italy Market Place  
(5th Avenue, Liberty and Hill Streets)

**North Central**  
7th Ave Park  
(Ingalls Avenue and 7th Ave.)

**South Troy**  
Canal Street Park  
(3rd Street and Canal Ave.)
