Pledge of Allegiance

Commissioner Strichman discussed a pending grant agreement for infrastructure at Monument Square; pending legislation which requests that the New York State Legislature create a tax abatement on certain properties in Troy; and pending legislation which requests that the New York State Legislature amend the enabling legislation for City of Troy Industrial Development Authority.

Commissioner Strichman and Lewis Brown from Vesta Corporation discussed the pending sale of Diamond Rock I & II and a requested extension of the PILOT agreement.
